SAQQARA PYRAMIDS

Saqqara is the oldest Ancient Egyptian cemetery. It lies on a desert plateau, south-west of Cairo. Above rises the Step-Pyramid and mortuary compound, built by the engineer Imhotep for King Zoser. It is composed of six receding mastabas on top of each other.



GIZA PYRAMIDS AND SPHINX

The great pyramids are the only ones surviving of the seven wonders of the ancient world. They are Egypt's most visited monuments and among the world's greatest tourist attractions.

Giza's Great Pyramid (also called the Pyramid of Cheops) is not only this ancient site's most famous monument. It was built by the Pharaoh Khufu (commonly called by its Greek transliteration of Cheops) and was known to the ancient Egyptians as Ekhet Khufu ("Horizon of Khufu").



Sphinx is carved from a single piece of stone. It is a lion with the head of a pharaoh thought to be the portrait of Chephren.

MEMPHIS

Memphis was one of the oldest and most important cities in ancient Egypt, located at the entrance to the Nile River Valley near the Giza plateau. It served as the capital of ancient Egypt and an important religious cult center.



EGYPTIAN MUSEUM

The Egyptian Museum in Cairo contains the world's most extensive collection of Pharaonic antiquities. Includes the collection of over 100,000 items includes the treasures of Tutankhamon's tomb, mummies ranging from the 18th to the 20th Dynasties.



OLD COPTIC CAIRO

You will start your tour by following the steps of the holy family, visiting some of their landmarks in the unique area of the old Cairo, the only place in the world where you will see the whole landmarks of the three religions Jewdism, Christianity & Islam, all located in one place.



CITADEL OF SALADIN & MOHAMED ALY MOSQUE

The citadel was constructed by Salah El Din on the Moqattam hills in 1183 AD overlooking the whole city to be his defensive point against the attacks of the Crusaders.

The Mosque was designed by the architect Yousif Boushnaq, a Turkish man who came especially from Istanbul and built this Greg at mosque for Mohamed Ali, the ruler of Egypt (1805-1849) who ruled Over 45 years. During his reign, considerable changes in various aspects of the political, social and economic life occurred. This period is now known as the beginning of the Egyptian renaissance.



KHAN EI KHALILI

Khan El-Khalili bazaar is a major market in the Islamic district in Cairo. The bazaar district is one of Cairo's main attractions for tourists and Egyptians alike.



THE CAVE CHURCH

The Monastery of Saint Simon, is known as the Cave Church, is located in the Mokattam Mountain in southeastern Cairo, Egypt, in an area that is known as 'garbage city' because of the large population of garbage collectors that live there.



CAIRO TOWER

The Cairo tower or El Gezira tower or (Borg El qazierah) in Arabic language is considered one of the most prominent features of the Egyptian capital. Its partially open lattice e-work design is Intended to evoke a lotus plant. It is higher than the great pyramid of Giza by 50 meters and it contains 16 floors.



NILOMETER

The Nilometer on Rhoda Island dates back to 861, and it is an ancient instrument used to measure the waters of the Nile so it can be a great help for Egyptian farmers While Nilometer originated in Pharaonic times, they continued to be used by the later civilizations that held sway in Egypt. Some were constructed in Roman times.



National Museum of Egyptian Civilization

The NMEC is the first of its kind in Egypt and the Arab world. It presents the full range of the richness and diversity of Egyptian civilization throughout the ages, from prehistoric times to the present day by focusing on its continuity and stability as demonstrated by its tangible and intangible heritage. The museum's exceptional collection includes the royal mummies, which are exhibited in a new interactive display using 21st century cutting-edge technology to go beneath the wrappings and reveal their secrets, in addition to shedding light on the rituals and religious beliefs surrounding mummification in ancient Egypt.



Mohamed Ali Palace (Al Manial Palace)

The Museum of Prince Muhammad Ali's Palace in Manial is one of the most beautiful and important historical museum in Egypt. The museum exhibits an important period in the history of modern Egypt and is characterized by its architectural design. Its modern Islamic style merges with Persian and Mamluk elements. It was also inspired by Syrian, Moroccan and Andalusian motifs, as well as Ottoman style. The building thus harmonises between a number of Islamic architectural traditions.
